What is the FELL-18 programme?

The 18 Future Energy Leaders of Lebanon (FELL-18) programme:

- is designed to **inspire, grow and develop** Lebanon's energy leaders of tomorrow;
- provides a platform to build a **rich professional network** to interact with senior energy leaders in the country and across the world;
- and connects the young energy professionals of Lebanon to a **global network of future energy leaders** through interaction with the WEC Council's FEL-100 programme.

What is the World Energy Council (WEC)?

The World Energy Council is the main independent network of leaders and practitioners around the globe which promotes affordable, stable and environmentally sensitive energy systems for the greatest benefit of all.

What is the WEC Lebanon National Committee?



Lebanon joined the World Energy Council in October 2011.

Hosted by the Lebanese Center for Energy Conservation (LCEC).

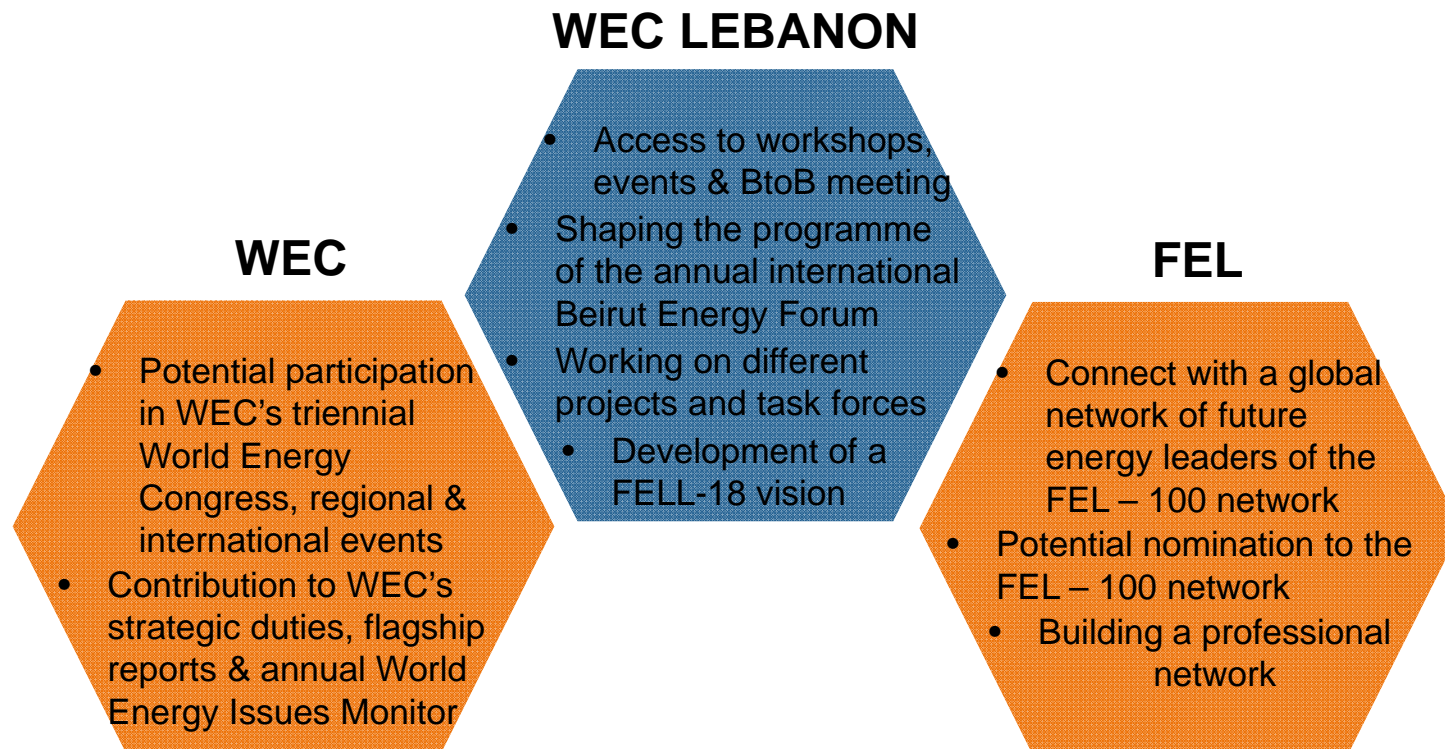
What are the scope and objectives of FELL-18?

What are the FELL-18 programme's duration and term?

- Yearly Programme
- Membership can be renewed for 1 year; maximum up to 3 years upon successfully passing evaluation
- 12 members: offered the opportunity to remain in the program
- 6 new members: selected yearly
- Participants, at the end of their tenure, join the FELL-18 Alumni network

What are the FELL-18 programme's criteria?

Eligibility Criteria

Solid interest and proven track record in energy

Obtained a bachelor's degree or higher

Minimum of 3 years full-time post-graduate and professional experience in an energy-related field

Ready to show commitment, remaining engaged for at least one year

Highly motivated with advanced level of English

Lebanese citizen or residing in Lebanon; not more than 35 years old

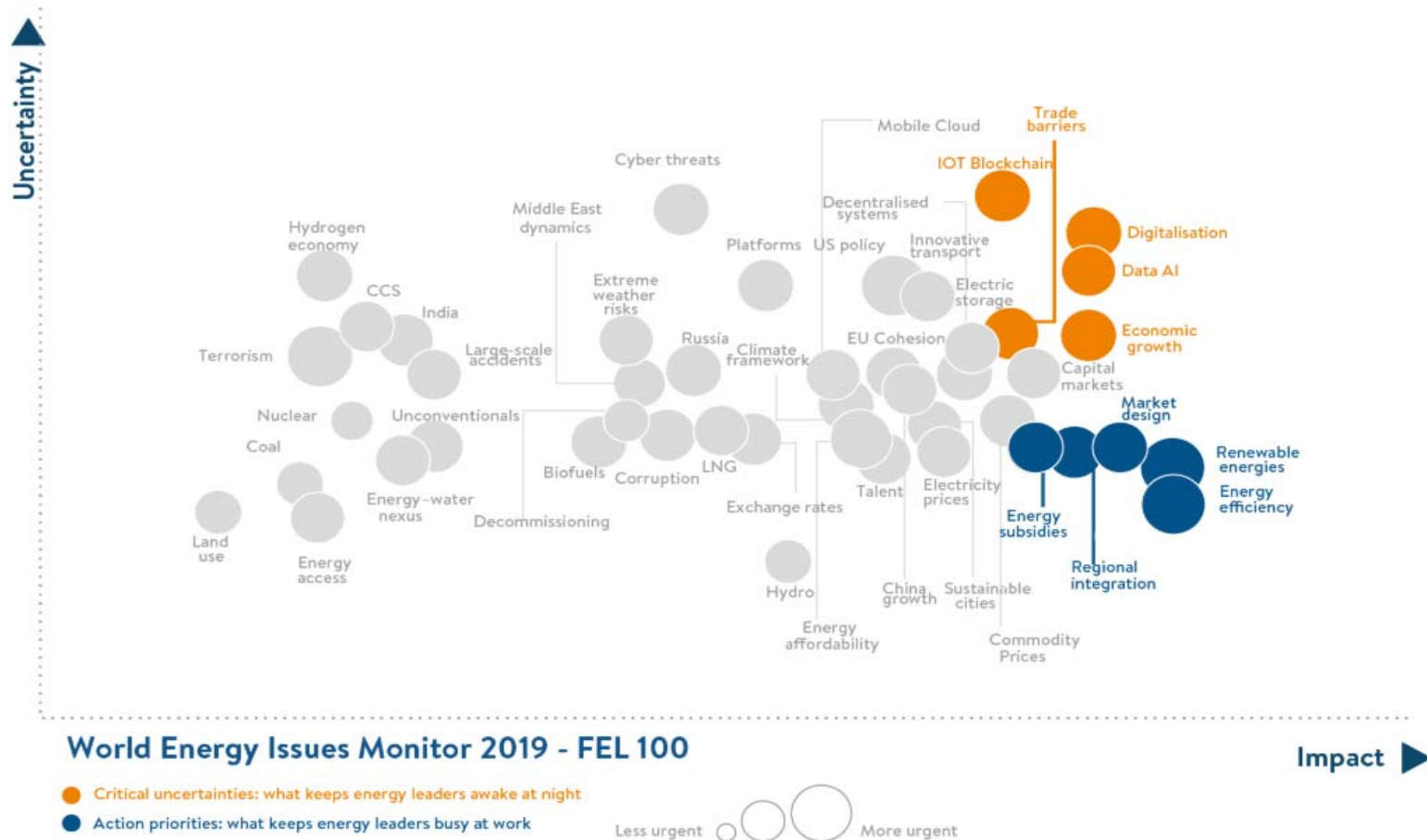
Minimum Criteria

Be an active member of one of the task forces and projects identified or endorsed by the World Energy Council Lebanon National Committee, including participation in meetings/calls, contribution to project plans, and contribution to deliverables

If possible, participate in one of the FELL-18 own events

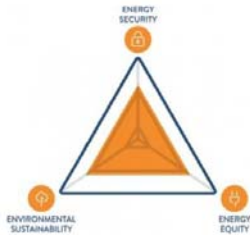

Trilemma



- Balance between energy security, energy equity, and environmental sustainability
- Assist in the development of the Trilemma Index for Lebanon

Human Capital



- Assess national competences
- Develop training and awareness raising material
- Assist in the development of a WE Academy for Lebanon

Digitalization



- Identify future infrastructure, including scenarios for Lebanon
- Assist in the development of a national scenario for the energy sector in Lebanon (visionario) for 2060
